Middle and high-schoolers hoping to own their own business one day can apply for a full scholarship to the Young Entrepreneurs Academy at SUNY Geneseo.

Teaching young people to be entrepreneurs is what the local academy is working to do.

Sixth through 12th graders get the chance to join, but there's a deadline approaching.

Students in the Young Entrepreneurs Academy develop a business plan and pitch it to investors. If the deal sells, they can start their own business in 31 weeks.

"We're in our fourth year at the University of Rochester," said Gayle Jagel of the Academy. "In October, we will launch a site of the Young Entrepreneurs Academy at SUNY Geneseo. It's an opportunity for students in a nine-county region to now participate in the academy closer to their homes."
