Students learn about new business ventures

Students from the University of Rochester's Entrepreneurs Academy are filing forms to start new businesses at the Monroe County Clerk's Office this afternoon, as part of a business development program. Twenty-seven students between the ages of 11 and 19 are taking part in a 9-month program that guides them through the steps of starting their own business or social movement. Part of today's field trip includes meeting Monroe County Clerk Cheryl Dinolfo.
