

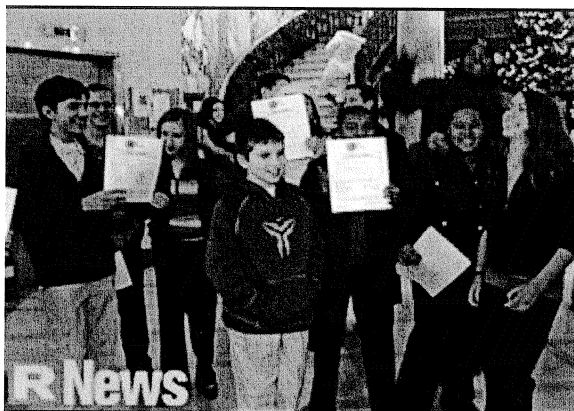
Young Entrepreneurs Receive DBAs
